Over the next 5 years we want to triple this figure to 6 million children.

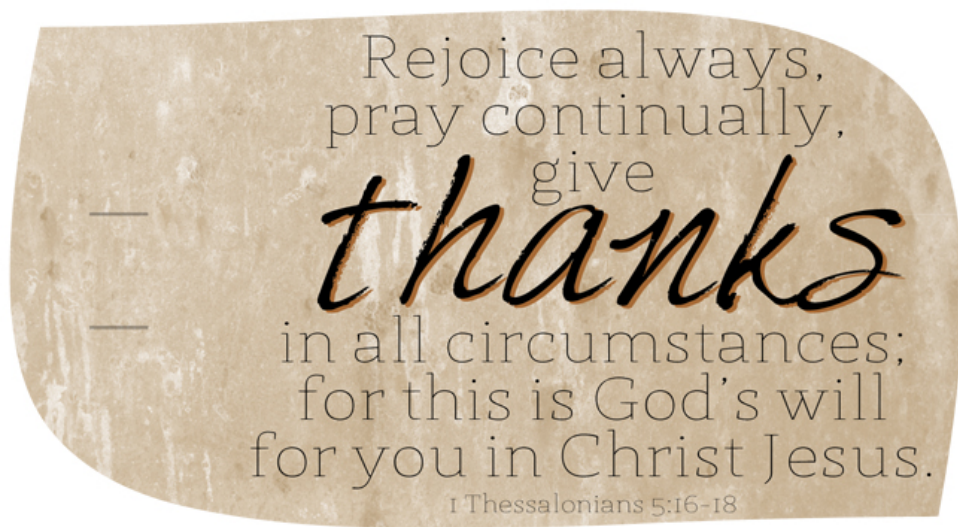
