our church. The work can be undertaken in three phases, starting with essential structural inspections and stabilizing work. The estimate, for all three phases, of works is £100k + 20% VAT and professional fees at 30%. Inflation costs to be added dependent on start date and duration of works. The total cost will be around £150k to date.

The Minister and two of the NPBC leadership team requested a further meeting with Rapleys to discuss any alternatives to the ongoing structural/maintenance costs of our existing building services. Adam Harvey, a specialised advisor for charities and experienced working with organisations including: the Church of England, United Reformed Church and Baptist Union on new church build projects was present.

Adam, from Rapleys LLP, confirmed a wide range of services including cost consultants and project managers in the pre-development stages of projects to replace existing church buildings. These are typically funded through an element of residential development paying for new modern church buildings. These are large sums of money. There's lots to share, discuss, and pray about.
