What is Holocaust Memorial Day?

'Millions of Jews and others killed during the Holocaust are being remembered in services across the UK, as part of Holocaust Memorial Day. In the UK, Holocaust Memorial Day takes place on 27 January. It marks the anniversary of the liberation of the Auschwitz concentration camp by soldiers of the Soviet Army in 1945. The day is a national mark of respect for all victims of the Holocaust as well as victims of other genocide around the world.'

It helps to educate people about the terrible events and it shows how important it is to be tolerant of other people and their beliefs. Marking the day also makes sure the Holocaust is not forgotten and can help to stop anything like it ever happening again.'

IN GENESIS

Jesus is the Ram at Abraham's Altar

This week's scripture reading (Genesis 22:1-18)

9 *'When they reached the place God had told him about, Abraham built an altar there and arranged the wood on it. He bound his son Isaac and laid him on the altar, on top of the wood. 10 Then he reached out his hand and took the knife to slay his son. 11 But the angel of the Lord called out to him from heaven, "Abraham! Abraham!"*

"Here I am," he replied.

12 *"Do not lay a hand on the boy," he said. "Do not do anything to him. Now I know that you fear God, because you have not withheld from me your son, your only son."*

13 *Abraham looked up and there in a thicket he saw a ram caught by its horns. He went over and took the ram and sacrificed it as a burnt offering instead of his son. 14 So Abraham called that place The Lord Will Provide. And to this day it is said, "On the mountain of the Lord it will be provided."*
