With national elections only months away, pray for the country, its people and its government, that there will be peace and justice for all, and that the church will continue to have a positive influence. Pray for Pastor Moises as he leads the national Baptist Church as well as being the pastor of a large church which reaches out into the community. Pray for John Wickes and Heather Pritchard at Kedesh Centre as they prepare to receive the first BMS Action team in Mozambique in the autumn.
