

Prayer Points and Information

Pray for the children and young people in our church as they have now returned to school after the Christmas break.

Continue to pray for those who are feeling poorly, or who are struggling in other ways – that they will know strength and peace and healing from God.

Pray for elderly and infirm people who live alone and have little contact with family members and neighbours.

Pray that the 17 UN Sustainable Development Goals that take effect from this month, tackling a wide range of global problems from poverty to environmental issues, will be effective, with many countries working together to achieve them by 2030.

Pray for God's wisdom and compassion as European governments struggle to contain and provide for the vast number of refugees and migrants from Syria and elsewhere, who have been forced to abandon their homes because of brutal conflict there.

Pray for the work of BMS World Mission in Mozambique: (1) for Pastor Moises Quembo who heads the Mozambican Baptist Convention, thanking the Lord for his ministry and asking that he may lead with clear vision, firm decision making and as a vehicle of God's love; (2) for team leader Fiona Welsh, training churches for community development, that God will give her grace and patience in her leadership; (3) for Carlos Tique Jone, who leads agricultural development work; (4) for the churches to catch the vision for improving the quality of life for all and thus show God's love in practice.
