

Prayer Points and Information

A prayer for Remembrance Sunday: 'Almighty God, we stand in silent respect, and think of the millions of men and women who have died or been wounded in the World Wars and many conflicts since. Thank you for your mercy and compassion towards those who suffer and those who grieve. Amen.'

Recent research suggests that three out of four churches support a local food bank alongside a diversity of other ministries such as homeless projects, street pastors and debt interaction. Let's pray for these projects and others like them, that those on the receiving end of such support will experience the love of Christ through his people and come to know him for themselves if they don't already.

Pray for people employed in the Civil Service to carry out Government policies, and also for those who work for the Local Authority. Ask God to inspire a spirit of excellence, and help those with leadership roles to be wise and committed to good work.

The European Baptist Federation (EBF) is made up of more than 770,000 Baptists in around 13,000 churches, stretching from Portugal to the far reaches of Russia. Pray for: (1) Tony Peck (from the UK), EBF General Secretary, offering leadership, counsel and encouragement; (2) Helle Liht (from Estonia), EBF Assistant General Secretary; (3) Daniël Trusiewicz (from Poland), coordinating the EBF 'Indigenous Mission Partnership', which supports those planting churches.
