

# Prayer Points and Information

Pray for the millions of individuals being trafficked. Ask God that politicians and others with influence in the UK Parliaments and Assemblies and the EU would support legislation to give protection and care to those who have been trafficked and abused, and ensure that traffickers are brought to justice.

Remember Greece and other countries in the Eurozone that are struggling with major debt problems. Ask God to give wisdom to their leaders as to the best strategies to take them through this period of austerity, whilst providing for people's needs. Pray for the increasing numbers of Christian initiatives helping with debt problems. Pray for individual counsellors, local church-run centres and organisations such as Christians Against Poverty and Credit Action. Remember people on fixed incomes, particularly those who are older, as they try to manage the rising costs of living. Pray that individuals and families in genuine financial need will be supported through the generosity, advice and friendship of others.

Pray for the 1,600 believers who make up the indigenous Church in Tunisia. Ask God's blessing on them as they gather for worship. Pray for the work of BMS in Tunisia: (1) for wisdom for Grace and Taieb, serving in leadership roles; (2) for Naama, who is supporting special needs educators and helping local organisations to provide a better quality of care; (3) for David and Louise, working to develop a community palliative care service in Tunisia.
