Monday 14 July is Disability Awareness Day. Pray that those with disabilities will have opportunities to lead independent and fulfilled lives. Pray especially for children and for their families. Ask God to help them through the challenges, fears and disappointments and find healing, happiness and peace in unexpected places.

David and Margie Whitehorn ask for prayer for: (1) workers for the centre in Chad; (2) workers for the Mwani team in Mozambique; (3) continued growth of the small group of Biafada believers in Guinea-Bissau; (4) the ministry of starting a sending base in Africa in order to equip and train people to be involved in cross-cultural mission; (5) African brothers and sisters to join teams so that they can serve God together in sharing the good news of Jesus; (6) effective networking with existing African agencies.

Pray for the work of BMS World Mission in Bangladesh. Thank God for the relative quiet with which the elections ended, which marked an end to a series of work stoppages that disrupted normal life. Pray that now, after the elections and as the nation has returned to normalcy, the ruling party and government may be able to establish a stable environment in Bangladesh. Praise God for the visa approvals received for mission personnel Andrew and Gwen Millns and Gemma Leadley. Pray for the team in Bangladesh – for opportunities to minister creatively and in meaningful ways to share the gospel of the kingdom and build local leadership capacity.
