On Remembrance Sunday, without ever delighting in the horror of war, let's be thankful for those who have given their lives on our behalf. As we do so, let's commit to the Lord our ongoing concerns about the many parts of the world today where fighting, violence and bloodshed are an everyday occurrence.

Pray for God's blessing on the Brigade, for the children who attend, and for Ruth Rego and the others who lead every week.

14-18 November is Anti-Bullying Week. Let's pray for children whose lives are overshadowed by the experience of being bullied, whether face-to-face or on social media. Pray that resources, training and individual support will be increasingly available for both children and adults who suffer in this way.

A prayer about persecution: Mighty God, we lift to you the worsening situation throughout the world where Christians suffer fierce persecution. We especially lift up those in the ten most badly affected countries: North Korea, Somalia, Iraq, Syria, Afghanistan, Sudan, Iran, Pakistan, Eritrea, and Nigeria. Amen.

Pray for BMS World Mission Home Staff, who are based in the UK: (1) for General Director David Kerrigan, and other directors, managers, team leaders and co-ordinators; (2) for staff in the Department for World Mission, as they relate directly to mission workers, partners and volunteers; (3) for staff at the BMS International Mission Centre, who train people for effective, ethical and sustainable mission. Ask God to inspire them all with his vision, and give them wisdom and grace for their work.
