

Prayer Points and Information

Pray for peace, strength, and the assurance of God's presence for Ola and her family as they grieve the recent death of her fiancé. Pray too for Val and the family following the death of her sister-in-law.

Pray for the opportunities churches (including ourselves) have at this time of year of welcoming people who might not normally attend a service. Pray that the Lord will bless the message of Christmas – of Jesus born as Saviour and Lord – to the hearts of people during the festivities.

Pray for those working in legal, banking and finance, and other highly pressured employment sectors, demanding long hours, that they would maintain a healthy approach to work in relation to other aspects of life. In addition, let's ask God to give insight to governments and others who are seeking to avert risks to world trade and commerce, such as fluctuating prices, conflicts, natural disasters, corruption, cyber attacks, and financial instability.

Pray for the community maternal health awareness project recently started by Haiti Hospital Appeal in Cap-Haitien, northern Haiti. Give thanks particularly for funds acquired through the British Government. Pray for good community relationships as Andrea Hotchkin leads the Guinebor II safe birthing project in Chad. This project will require a strong working relationship with local Islamic religious leaders. Pray for the midwives being mentored and trained within the hospital during the three year life cycle of this project.
