

Prayer Points and Information

Pray for God's blessing on the Girls' Brigade – for the girls (and boys!) who meet every week, and for those who lead and help. Pray too for restoration to full health and strength for Ruth Rego.

During this period of Lent, leading up to the events of Easter, let's pray that God will give us a fresh awareness of his amazing grace.

Pray that Christian songwriters, performers and others in the music industry will find ways to apply their faith to all they produce.

Pray for those in the police, ambulance, fire and other emergency services who may find themselves in perilous situations at any time. Ask God to grant extra courage, clarity and great skill on such occasions and help them to protect and rescue people in danger. Pray for the National Crime Agency, fighting an estimated 5,500 organised crime groups targeting the UK. Pray for success against cyber, drug, trafficking, sexual abuse and other heinous criminal activities that blight communities, ruin lives and cost the UK well over £20 billion each year.

Pray for the work of BMS World Mission in Albania. Give thanks for the ten Albanian Baptist churches as they meet for worship, and for the development of the Union that unites them, chaired by Mondi Palucaj. Pray for BMS supported partner workers Dyshi and Endri Tabaku, pastoring the Light of the World Baptist Church in Shkozë, on the edge of Tirana, and ministering to a nearby Roma community. Pray too for Fredi Gollosi, planting Freedom Baptist Church in a converted shop in central Tirana and reaching out to the urban poor.
