

Prayer Points and Information

Give thanks to God for those who have been baptised over this weekend from various local churches, including our own. Ask that God will encourage them in their relationship with him and their witness to family and friends and colleagues.

Sunday 14 September is Racial Justice Sunday. Give thanks for the diversity of the church in Britain: its wealth of different traditions, worship styles, testimonies and ways of serving Christ through evangelism, prayer, education, community involvement and compassionate action. Pray that Christians will model what it looks like to be outward-looking and welcoming towards people from all ethnic cultures. Pray too for those living in places that are being torn apart by acts of ethnic violence resulting in deaths, kidnappings, the destruction of communities and people having to flee from their homes. Pray for those seeking to help in such tragic situations.

Continue to pray for full recovery for Lynn Green, General Secretary of the Baptist Union, following recent radiotherapy treatment.

BMS staff and mission workers ask for prayer that: (1) they will be men and women with pure hands and a clean heart; (2) every piece of BMS work, at home and abroad, will bear the hallmark of evangelistic intent; (3) they will look for, and discover, creative ways of telling the gospel story and transforming broken lives; (4) they will be shaped by global voices in a way that will inform and strengthen their work.
