

Prayer Points and Information

Pray that the re:focus consultation we have been doing as a church will bear good fruit and will give us more confidence to speak about Jesus to people we encounter in our everyday lives.

Continue to pray for strength and restoration for those among us who are poorly and who have been receiving treatment.

Sunday 16 February is Education Sunday. Pray for local schools – and for the children in our church who attend them. Ask God to equip, bless and encourage students, staff and others who spend time in schools. Pray for teachers and other helpers to have the determination, patience, compassion and wisdom they need each day. Pray too for staff in local education authorities.

Ask God to grant discernment and integrity to Christians serving within the judicial system: prosecutors, defence lawyers, solicitors, judges, magistrates, jury members, court officials and others in support roles.

We continue to hear stories from Africa about children sold into slavery, women who have been abused or struggle to retain access to land, and men imprisoned without trial. The legal system seeks to protect against such injustices. Pray for BMS mission workers who are working alongside national legal workers in several African countries, including Annet Ttendo, Kathy Russell and Damien Miller (in Mozambique), and Eunice Nabafu and Amos (in Uganda).
