A prayer for World Social Work Day (Tuesday 18 March): 'Father God, please strengthen social workers worldwide who seek to help those in greatest need. Grant insight and compassion to governments to facilitate this vital support and protection for vulnerable children and adults. Amen.' Pray about the growing crisis in social work throughout Britain – increasing demands having to be met on reduced budgets by often poorly supported staff who manage high caseloads that require excessive administration.

The six colleges affiliated to the Baptist Union of Great Britain prepare men and women for ministry of all kinds, both lay and ordained, and offer ongoing ministerial development and training. Pray for those who work at the Colleges, and for students preparing for ministry.
