

Prayer Points and Information

Pray for all those involved with the children in Sunday Club; and pray for the children as well, that God's word would take root in their lives and bear fruit in a genuine relationship with the Lord Jesus, even at a young age.

Pray for those who continue to struggle with ill-health of different sorts – for grace in weakness, for a deep sense of God's presence, and for restored strength.

A prayer about music: 'Thank You, Lord, for music – an important feature of every culture and community – bringing people together to express their joys and sorrows and share their stories. May those who have musical gifts and skills bring increasing honour and glory to you through their practice and performance. Amen.'

Pray for those involved in chaplaincy for young people: in young offenders institutions, with Army, Navy and Airforce cadets, in hospitals, schools, colleges, adventure centres, sports teams and other settings. Ask God to give them opportunities to share the love of Christ in word and deed.

Pray for the work of BMS World Mission in Guinea. Pray for Victor, leading the team and getting involved in the local car mechanics school, where resources for teaching are limited, and for Caroline, his wife, starting community self-help income generation groups. Isabelle is seeking ways to be involved in children's welfare and education.
