

Prayer Points and Information

Pray for God's blessing on Dot Boylin as she adjusts to life in a new nursing home, and as she builds friendships with fellow residents. Pray that she will find comfort in the care of those who work there.

Pray for the 35,000 girls and women in China each day who have an abortion, very often against their will, and those elsewhere in the world who are forced to end their pregnancy because of cultural, economic or other social reasons. Pray for the many Christian pregnancy support centres in the UK that offer non-directional help to women, and also their partners and families. Ask God to provide for volunteer helpers and prayer and financial support, and for many to be directed to their doors.

The Whitehorns ask for urgent prayer for the Bourofaye Christian School in Senegal. The couple who are responsible for the finances and the primary teaching are having to return to the UK for a year, rather unexpectedly, to care for a parent, which leaves two vital vacancies for the coming academic year: a finance manager and a trained full-time primary teacher. Pray for these gaps (and also another primary teacher and a couple as dorm parents) to be filled.

Praise God for the ministry to teenagers in Baptist churches throughout Paraguay, led by Carol and Cesar Gonzalez, and pray for the ministry leaders they disciple to be examples of Christ in those churches. Pray for wisdom for pastors Fernando and Ruben, leading the Paraguayan Baptist Convention.
