Pray for peace and blessing for Rebekah Rego as she prepares to be baptised next Sunday (25 January), 11.00am, at Oldfield Free Church (Baptist), Malden Avenue, Greenford, UB6 0DJ.

Sunday 18 January is Homelessness Sunday. Thank God for local authorities and charities as well as churches who work among homeless people – giving them food and shelter, helping them to access health care and other support. Pray for staff and volunteers to have the capacity to deal with each case with wisdom and compassion. Pray for those who are not technically homeless, but exist out of sight in B&Bs, squats, on friends' and families' floors or sofas, or sleeping rough. Ask God to intervene in their broken lives.

Give thanks for the wonderful blessing older people can be in their relationships with grandchildren and other family members within the church and local community. Pray for elderly and infirm people who live alone and have little contact with family or neighbours.

Despite it being a very volatile period for the Middle East and North Africa, people are still turning to Christ. Pray through the challenges facing the church in this part of the world: identifying and training leaders, maintaining good relationships between traditional churches and new movements, developing a strong second generation of Christians. Pray too for God's grace for those who are being discriminated against, marginalised, detained, imprisoned, tortured and even killed for their faith in Jesus.
