

Prayer Points and Information

Pray for those you know who are struggling with life, whether through physical illness, emotional distress, tiredness, bereavement, pressures at work, etc.

Pray for the leadership of the Baptist Union of Great Britain as it develops a new collaborative way of working together. Pray too for the General Secretary Lynn Green, new President Chris Ellis, and the Baptist Steering Group.

Let's continue to ask that God will show mercy in the currently troubled 'hot spots' around the world, such as Syria and Ukraine.

Pray for the European Parliament elections on 22 May in the UK and the following weekend for all other states. Ask God to guide those who vote, and strengthen all the Christian MEPs, candidates and their families during the pressures of an election campaign.

Pray for various projects assisted through the BMS Mission Innovation Fund, designed to support fresh ideas for integral mission to take place, including: (1) Arthur Brown's 'teen bus' project in Lebanon, used as a mobile youth outreach club for marginalised teenagers in Beirut; (2) Benjamin Francis' distribution of gospel messages on bus tickets, which aims to reach one million people in Kolkata, India; (3) ongoing evangelism following the Russian Ministries Bible distribution and sports camp outreach which focused on the Sochi Winter Olympics in February 2014.
