Let's pray for the church members' meeting next Sunday, that any decisions made would help strengthen us as the body of Christ and better equip us to engage with others in our everyday lives.

Pray for renewed strength for those who have been suffering in various ways, whether physically, emotionally, with anxiety, depression, or in other ways.

Pray for Christians who have been unfairly treated in the workplace because they have spoken of their faith, or refused to act against their conscience. Pray that they would be wise in such matters, but also ready to witness for Christ in a gracious spirit.

Give thanks to God for the anti-trafficking legislation that is now in place in every part of the UK, resulting in perpetrators of trafficking, sexual and other exploitation being prosecuted and victims having the right to justice and proper care. Pray that these laws will be increasingly effective in the fight against modern slavery.

Flooding in East Africa is causing food shortages, and reduced monsoons have created difficult conditions for farmers in India. Let's pray for all poor communities working to become climate resilient.

Pray for the BMS International Mission Centre as the staff there develop training for UK churches in various aspects of cross-cultural mission. Pray for the Missional Community: a group of mission leaders from within the Baptist family across the UK who, together with BMS, are seeking to lead churches in effective mission engagement.
