Let's continue to pray for God's blessing over the next few months during the 're:focus' process of reflecting together on where we are as a church, and as we consider how we might engage more effectively with those we meet in our everyday lives.

This week is the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. We join with our brothers and sisters in Christ from all churches around the world to pray for the unity which is found through Christ. The new Baptist Steering Group meets for the first time this week. Pray for the group as they consider how best to implement Council's vision for our Union in the months ahead.

Pray for those who work in unsafe situations: in the Armed Forces, protecting the public from criminal activity and terrorist threats, engaging in search and rescue operations and emergency services.

Pray for people who need physical, emotional, psychological and spiritual healing. Pray for Christians seeking to help them by giving professional medical and nursing care, practical help and comfort.

Pray for the European Baptist Federation, led by Tony Peck, bringing together more than 770,000 Baptists from 52 unions across Europe, the Middle East and Central Asia. Give thanks for the various prayer movements in Europe: including the Evangelical Alliance Week of Prayer, 24/7 Prayer, Prayer for Muslims during Ramadan, as well as many national and local initiatives.
