Pray for Lukas Shindeldecker, the head of the Community Development sector of BMS partner the Lebanese Society for Educational and Social Development, as he and his team coordinate a multi-faceted humanitarian response to the Syrian crisis. Pray too for the Learning Support Project in Beirut, headed by Louise Brown, providing education for Lebanese and Syrian children who would otherwise be at risk of dropping out of the school system.
