As Charmaine is now into her seventh year (!) as pastor of NPBC, let's continue pray for wisdom for her ongoing leadership. Pray too for our deacons and others involved in pastoral oversight.

Pray for wisdom and strong foundations to be laid as mission-focused churches are being planted in communities where few understand the message of the gospel: on rundown estates, among special interest groups, such as bikers, and in coffee shops, pubs and homes. Ask God to equip and energise every Christian helping with thousands of Alpha, Christianity Explored and other evangelistic courses this autumn in communities across the UK. Pray for many of the participants to receive the message of salvation gladly.

Pray for the Party leaders and members of the Scottish Parliament following September's referendum, that sound plans and renewed unity and understanding about the nation's greatest priorities will come together and will contribute to the common good.

Pray for David and Margie Whitehorn as they leave for Ghana on 20 October and return to the UK on 7 November. Pray for strength and wisdom as they take part in the WEC-related National Church Assembly and the WEC team conference, giving devotions and leading a workshop in peacemaking. They are also planning to spend time with one of the teams in the north of the country where they have never visited before; pray that they will be a blessing and encouragement to the leaders of the team there.
