A prayer about generosity: 'Lord Jesus, teach us to be generous; teach us to serve you as you deserve, to give and not to count the cost, to fight and not to heed the wounds, to toil and not to seek for rest, to labour and not to seek reward, except that of knowing that we do your will. Amen.'

Pray for the annual gathering of the Baptist World Alliance which takes place this week, as Baptists from all over the world gather in Bangkok to pray, worship, and discuss together issues affecting Baptists and our world, and to promote fellowship and cooperation.

Ask God to give wisdom about the rapidly expanding technology of robotics and Artificial Intelligence that many predict will transform society. Pray for Christians who are working in these areas to have insight and influence, and for God's will to be done in the years ahead. Pray too for researchers who are developing ethically sound life-saving pharmaceuticals, medical procedures and other treatments. Pray that projects involving morally questionable techniques will continue to be outlawed.

Pray for the relationships between BMS World Mission and their partners as they seek to transform vulnerability to resilience in the name of Jesus. Pray for Owen Davies and his veterinary work in rural Nepal. Pray for healthy livestock and strong community acceptance. Pray for BMS livelihoods work amongst farmers in northern Uganda. Pray for good harvests and a good price for cash crops. Pray for the small businesses being supported through the BMS Loans for Life project in Mozambique. Pray for good returns and full loan repayment.
