Pray that God will continue to strengthen our relationships with each other in the wider family of the church, that we will learn to love one another more, care for one another with sincerity of heart, and seek to serve one another.

A prayer for the start of Lent this Wednesday (5 March): 'Merciful Lord, grant us grace to withstand temptation and with pure hearts and minds to follow you. Amen' (from the Book of Common Prayer).

Pray for Christians in banking and financial services to shine as lights – illuminating what is honourable, especially where dishonest practices occur. Ask God to give those in authority his wisdom about economic issues affecting the UK and beyond.
