

Prayer Points and Information

Ask God to bless the ongoing preparation for the holiday club.

Pray for those working in particularly stressful situations as paramedics, in Accident and Emergency, Intensive Care and other critical services. Ask God to protect and strengthen them so they keep calm and bring comfort and effective treatment.

Many new wounds, bitterness, fear, anger and suffering have been created during the current crisis in Israel and the Palestinian Territories. Pray for peace and healing to start the process of repairing damaged lives, and that communities will be able to live in respect, dignity and security with each other. Pray for Christians and churches and mission organisations in Israeli, Arab-Israeli and Palestinian communities – that God will give them wisdom in how best to minister to the people they serve at this very challenging time.

Pray for Haiti. It is the poorest country in the western hemisphere and is prone to both natural disasters and political vulnerability. Pray for political stability and a healthy relationship with its influential neighbour, the Dominican Republic. Pray for BMS mission worker Andy Cowie as he teaches mechanic skills to young people in Port-au-Prince. Pray for Jutta Cowie, who leads the joint Co-operative Baptist Fellowship and Haitian Baptist Convention Self-Help Group programme – aiming to provide training to communities who wish to escape the aid dependency trap.
