

Prayer Points and Information

Pray for the church members' meeting next Sunday, that any decisions made would help strengthen us as the body of Christ and better equip us to engage with others in our everyday lives.

Sunday 21 September is International Day of Peace. Pray for countries where there is little peace and security. Remember diplomats, UN Peacekeepers, Christian emissaries and others who go to dangerous places to negotiate justice and peace, often in the crossfire. Ask God to protect them, to help them gain people's trust and persuade them to consider pursuing paths of reconciliation that will benefit everyone.

Pray for Christians who have been unfairly treated in the workplace because they have spoken of their faith, or refused to act against their conscience. Pray that they would be wise in such matters, but also ready to witness for Christ in a gracious spirit.

Pray for the Home Mission department of the Bulgarian Baptist Union, aiming to train, send and support church planters in strategic areas. Pray too for the Union's General Secretary Teddy Oprenov. Pray for the Baptist work among the Roma people in Bulgaria. As in the country at large, the Roma are well represented in the Baptist family but their congregations are particularly poor. Pray for Jozsef Csuha, co-ordinating the Baptist Roma mission in Hungary, and for the fast-growing Roma churches that have a vision to reach Roma beyond Hungary's borders.
