Pray for Alistair Burt MP, Minister for Community and Social Care, as he seeks to apply his Christian faith to his wide ranging responsibilities for older people, dementia, adult social care, carers, end-of-life care, mental health services and prison services.

Afghanistan continues to be rated as one of the most under-developed and fragile states in the world. It is also one of the least reached nations. Thank God for his protection for BMS World Mission personnel and others who serve in Afghanistan. Pray for its government as it seeks to improve security and safety. Pray too for the General Assembly and Board meetings of BMS' partner agency that have been completed this month: for wisdom and guidance in carrying through the decisions made. Pray for the strength for the staff who are stretched in their roles and responsibilities, for their wellbeing, ability to cope, and sustenance as they serve.
