Pray ahead of next week's meeting with Hilary Taylor and David Priddy, as part of the re:focus consultation we have been doing as a church. Pray for sensitivity to hear God's voice to us as a church.

Give thanks for all those who devote themselves to helping people whose lives are difficult because they lack freedom, security, clean water and food, medical care, education and other benefits that we may take for granted. Ask God to strengthen individuals who endure pain and uncertainty about the future because of life-threatening conditions. Pray for God to pour his peace into their hearts and reveal to them the living hope we have in Christ Jesus.

24 February to 9 March is Fair Trade Fortnight. This year sees the launch of their 'Abolish the Unfair Banana' campaign. Pray for justice for those at the sharp end of the supply chain, the millions of struggling banana farmers and workers, that they may get a fair deal.

BMS appointed new International Mission Centre Directors last autumn. Pray for Claire and Mark Ord as they prepare to take on this varied and exciting ministry.

Pray for Ukraine: that the current unrest comes to a peaceful conclusion, that the army will keep its vow not to act against the people, that the church leaders of all denominations will be given courage to continue to speak out and pray for peace.
