

Prayer Points and Information

Pray that God's word would lodge in our minds, hearts, and lives as we seek to live well and witness to Christ in our everyday situations.

Let's thank God for the children he has entrusted to us as a church, and pray that – from crèche onwards – they will be nurtured in their lives and come to faith in Jesus.

Pray for wisdom and strong foundations to be laid as mission-focused churches are being planted in communities where few understand the message of the gospel: on rundown estates, among special interest groups, such as bikers, and in coffee shops, pubs and homes. Ask God to equip and energise every Christian helping with thousands of Alpha, Christianity Explored and other evangelistic courses this autumn in communities across the UK. Pray that many of the participants will gladly receive the message of salvation.

Pray about the continuing dispute between the NHS and junior doctors, and the consequences that any strikes would have for patients. Pray for a wise and workable solution to be found to this crisis and also to the growing financial pressures seriously affecting all our health services.

Pray for BMS palliative care work in North Africa – particularly for BMS nurses as they tend to those approaching the end of their lives. Pray for BMS worker Judy Cook and her co-workers at Hope Home, as they seek to provide care for severely disabled children in Thailand. Pray for BMS doctors Andrea and Mark Hotchkin, as they enable government hospitals to become functional on behalf of the community in rural Chad.
