Remember those working within the UN and other agencies helping to safeguard vulnerable water systems from disasters such as floods and droughts. Pray for the success of work in countries that are trying to improve the quality of water supplies.

Pray for Peru's Evangelical Baptist Convention, and for God's blessing on Julio Montalvo, President of the Convention, and other directors, as they prepare for the Peruvian Baptist Assembly which takes place this week.
