A prayer for Christmas day: Lord Jesus, we join with the angels and all the company of heaven today to celebrate the wonderful truth of your coming to earth as a baby to rescue us from our sin! We worship you, giving thanks for your mercy and grace. Amen.

Let's ask God to speak to all those who do not usually attend church, but like to go to a Christmas service. Let's continue to pray about the ongoing situation in Aleppo, Syria, and in other troubled spots around the world.
