Let's continue to pray for a good recovery for those who have been in hospital recently, and for God's strength for others who are currently struggling with ill health of different sorts.

Pray that those of us who gather for our away day next Saturday will have a great time in being together and learning from each other.

Pray that the numbers of people being killed or hurt in road traffic accidents in Britain – still high in 2015 at 1,732 fatalities and 22,137 serious injuries – will continue to fall. Pray that wise speed restrictions, improved vehicle design, and more effective public safety information for all road users will contribute to this.

A Prayer from Baptist chaplain Cole Maynard for Armed Forces Day (24 June): 'Lord God, we commend to your gracious care and keeping all the men and women in our Armed Forces at home and abroad. Defend them in the hour of danger; strengthen them in trials and temptations; enable them to fulfil their duty in serving our nation with loyalty, courage and honour, and help them to know that nothing can separate them from your love, through Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.'
