

Prayer Points and Information

Pray for those who are currently suffering with ill health, or who have been undergoing tests and procedures.

The launch date for Ealing Foodbank Northolt (based at NPBC) is Thursday 3 July. Let's pray for the success of this venture – that we will show God's love by helping to feed the hungry.

Remember frail elderly people in care homes and hospital wards who are ill-treated and neglected because they have no family or friends to speak up for them. Pray that in such cases staff and others with concerns will be able to inform the authorities. Pray for elderly people at risk from natural disasters, conflicts, epidemics and famine affecting them and their families. Pray too for elderly infirm refugees from countries such as Syria and South Sudan, living in great fear and uncertainty.

Pray for the work of BMS World Mission and their partners in France, including: (1) for Glyn Hackett, the French Baptist Federation's newly appointed Head of Development, as he helps Baptist churches across the country to discern the best way to communicate their faith and to grow; (2) for the French Baptist 'Home Mission' team, led by Philip Halliday and working closely with Glyn Hackett, as they support and encourage the 16 Baptist church-plants across France; (3) for John and Sue Wilson, leading the city-centre Baptist church in Lyons and preparing to plant a second congregation on the other side of the city.
