

Prayer Points and Information

Let's pray for the safety of children who are out trick-or-treating on Halloween, and pray for those who come along to the Light Party at our church, that they will not only have a fun time but will be drawn closer to the light that Jesus brings in a world of darkness.

Continue to pray for strength and patience for those in our church fellowship and wider families who are poorly, who are awaiting test results or undergoing ongoing treatment.

Today, Sunday 26 October, is a Day of Prayer About Abortion. Pray for women who have had a miscarriage or undergone an abortion, perhaps against their wishes, and that those suffering physical and emotional pain or regret following an abortion would experience God's comfort and love – especially through the loving support of compassionate Christians.

Pray for the staff at the BMS International Mission Centre in Birmingham as they train and prepare future mission workers.

Pray for Christians in the Middle East and North Africa, many of whom suffer in silence, cut off from family and isolated from Christian fellowship. Pray that God would meet with them in a powerful way. Pray too for God's grace and strength to be with those Christians in the region who are being discriminated against, marginalised, detained, imprisoned, tortured and even killed for their faith in Jesus Christ.
