Continue to pray for strength and peace for those who have been suffering in body and through bereavement over the last few weeks.

Give thanks for God's promise never to leave or forsake us. Praise him for the past year's times of celebration and gladness, but also for his grace in those situations that caused us pain. For we know that for those who love God all things work together for good.

Friday 2 January is International Day for the Abolition of Slavery. Ask the Lord to draw close to the estimated one million children worldwide who are trafficked each year for cheap labour or sexual exploitation. Give thanks that in recent years the reality of this appalling trade has become far more widely known and much effort is now being made to eradicate it throughout the world.

Pray for those who are serving God in places where Christians are not permitted to live out their faith openly. Ask God to provide for all their needs and enable them to be light-bearers in dark places.

Leadership training is a key aspect of BMS World Mission. Pray for the BMS team at the Nauta Mission Centre in the Amazon region of Peru as they invest in training local leaders. Pray too for those involved in mentoring relationships in Tunisia, seeking to invest in palliative care. Pray for Roger Pearce, Director of GDQ School in Tirana, Albania, as he guides the school towards the completion of a process to gain a professional double accreditation.
