

Prayer Points and Information

Let's ask God to give us wisdom as we think and pray through the ongoing ministry of the church in the future.

Pray for those who are and have been poorly – that God would give them strength and hope in their weakness and heal them in body, soul, and mind.

29 February to 13 March is Fairtrade Fortnight. Pray for the many farmers in the developing world who are unfairly paid for what they produce. Ask God to challenge us to take any action we can to help ensure they are treated with dignity and justice. Pray too for staff and volunteers working with over 420 Trussell Trust and other foodbanks across the UK, that last year provided emergency food for over a million people – including almost 400,000 children. Give thanks for our own involvement in this as a church, and pray for those who ensure it happens.

Pray for those Christians who follow Jesus at risk to their lives.

Pray for Thailand, where Christians make up less than one per cent of the population. Give thanks for BMS personnel Helen and Withaya Boondeekhun as they begin church planting work in the country. Pray for wisdom and guidance for them. Pray for BMS partner NightLight in Bangkok. Pray for the women they work amongst, who have been trapped in exploitative situations, that they will experience the fullness of life that only Christ can give. Pray too for BMS personnel Brian and Lydia English (with baby Jesse) settling back into life and work in Thailand, with BMS partner organisation Compasio.
