

Prayer Points and Information

Continue to pray for those in the church who are poorly, and for others who are in need of strength and encouragement.

Pray about the issues of homelessness and food poverty in the UK. Thank God for thousands of local churches working together with various charities to try to meet these needs.

Ask God to watch over those who serve in our police forces and other law enforcement and security services. Pray for discernment, integrity, courage and success in their endeavours.

Thank God for all those who share the gospel message with people in places who have never heard or understood God's goodness and mercy through Christ. Pray for Bible translators, medical missionaries, teachers, engineers, relief and aid workers and others who serve in this way.

North Korea remains one of the world's most isolated countries. It is a country with many contrasts and concerns, with the ruling elite having great privileges while it seems many common people struggle for sufficient food. Pray for Kim Jong-un, known as the Supreme Leader, that he may seek changes that impact the good of all the people. Pray for improved international relationships, both on the Korean peninsula and further afield. Pray for strength and encouragement for the believers in the country, who are often severely persecuted if they identify as or are known to be Christians.
