A prayer for Ascension Sunday: 'Almighty God, your ascended Son has sent us into the world to spread the good news of your kingdom: inspire us with your Spirit and fill our hearts with the fire of your love, that all who hear your word may be drawn to you, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.'

Pray for God's blessing on Anna Smith, whatever the outcome of the decision made by the church members. Let's continue to ask God to give us wisdom and insight in the whole process of seeking and appointing a new pastor.

Pray for strength and peace for those who are currently suffering.

Pray for the Crown Prosecution Services in England, Wales and Northern Ireland and the Crown Office and Procurator Fiscal Service in Scotland as they advise police and review cases for possible prosecution, determine charges in more serious or complex cases and prepare and present cases at court. Ask God to encourage those who work in criminal, civil and family courts as clerks, ushers, probation officers, legal support staff, administrators, judges, magistrates and lawyers.

Thank God for schools in Albania, Nepal and Bangladesh, supported by BMS World Mission and enabling mission workers to stay and serve in country by educating their children. Pray for opportunities for BMS English language teachers in East Asia to develop friendships with those they teach. Pray for literacy programmes run by a BMS partner in Afghanistan, enabling adults to read and write for the first time.
