

Prayer Points and Information

Today – 28 September – is ‘Back to Church Sunday’. Pray for those who responded to an invitation to attend a church service today, that they will have felt welcome and at ease, and will be prompted to want to know more about Jesus.

A prayer for Wednesday 1 October, which is International Day for Older Persons: ‘Lord, please help us in our churches across the land to relate more effectively to those who are older, many with much to offer our communities and others in need of support and care. Grant that those whose faith needs rekindling will be encouraged to recommit their lives and remain faithful to Jesus. Amen.’

Let’s pray about the ongoing turmoil in Iraq and Syria: (1) pray for leaders of western governments and their advisors as they consider where and how to provide humanitarian assistance and military intervention; (2) pray for safety for Christians and other minorities who are fleeing violence and persecution; (3) pray for comfort for those who have lost loved ones and have suffered traumatic violence; (4) pray for Christian missionaries and aid workers who serve in difficult circumstances, that they will be kept safe, and that their efforts will contribute to a fuller realisation of the peace and flourishing that God intends for all; (5) pray that ISIS fighters will come to understand the horrific nature of their deeds and repudiate them, and turn to the God who raises the dead instead of one that raises the sword.
