Pray for all those involved with the children in Sunday Club. Let's also pray for the children themselves, that God's word would take root in their lives and bear fruit in a genuine relationship with the Lord Jesus, even at a young age.

Remember the one billion people, 80 per cent in the developing world, with disabilities that often cut them off from employment, education, social interaction and necessary healthcare. Give thanks for the courage and achievements of those who overcome difficulties and ask God to comfort those who are unable to improve their lives.

Saturday 4 February is World Cancer Day. Pray for those who are involved in research into how to prevent, diagnose and treat cancer, and the clinicians and therapists who care for patients. Give thanks that the survival rate has doubled since 1976 and pray for this trend to continue.

Pray for the BMS World Mission supported Nauta Integral Mission Training Centre (NIMTC) in Peru, a resource helping local, national and international church and mission groups. Give thanks for the NIMTC programme, teaching theology and community development, and pray for the 20 or so church leaders from jungle villages attending each year. Praise God for the opportunities BMS has to share the gospel with distant jungle villages and to encourage remote church communities to continue in the faith.
