

Prayer Points and Information

Pray for strength and grace for those who have been suffering – physically, emotionally, and in other ways – that they would know the presence of God with them.

Let's ask God for wisdom for ourselves as a body of Christ as church members consider and pray about the election of deacons in the run up to the AGM on 15 May.

Monday 4 April is Mine Awareness Day. Pray that highly trained specialist 'deminers' will be safe and successful in clearing valuable land of mines and other explosive remnants of war that kill and injure thousands of people every year and block access to healthcare, education and development.

Ask God to bless the work of Christian pregnancy advice centres around the country that offer support to women in times of crisis. Pray that many in need will be led to these helpful services.

The church in some parts of India faces opposition of various forms, but God continues to provide an open door to serve the people of this large and diverse country and to share the love of God. Pray for BMS personnel and their families who are settling into life in India. Pray particularly for good health, and for adaptation to schools and work in a new country and culture. Thank God for the Street Servants ministry. Founded on similar principles to Street Pastors, Street Servants is reaching out to the hundreds of homeless and impoverished people living on the streets of Kolkata. Thank God for a very positive reception by local pastors to the training on gender based violence delivered as part of BMS' Dignity initiative.
