

# Prayer Points and Information

On Mothering Sunday, give thanks for Mums. Pray too for those who grieve the loss of a mother or for whom, in other ways, this day is difficult. Pray for mothers who feel under pressure to spend time with spouses, children, extended family and friends, alongside responsibilities in the workplace and elsewhere.

Let's continue to pray about how we should move forward as a church after the recommendations from the re:focus consultation on issues related to learning, loving, worshipping, and evangelising.

Give thanks for every government and organisation committed to ending racial discrimination in society. Pray for those seriously affected by racist attitudes and actions to be strengthened through God's grace.

Pray for the upcoming elections in Bangladesh and the current unrest and disruption. Pray for peace to be preserved with the transition of control in Afghanistan.

Pray for Ukraine: (1) for the acting governmental leaders as they decide how to respond to Russia taking the Crimea back; (2) for Ukrainians, especially in the military, who are still in the Crimea; (3) for several Christian organisations and churches to unify in a major outreach to give many hurting and lost people in Ukraine a chance to know the Prince of Peace; (4) for the timely production of materials and person power to do this throughout the country.
