

Prayer Points and Information

Ask that God will inspire each of us with a powerful sense of his presence and work among us and through us as his people.

Pray for local schools – and for the children in our church – as most schools begin a new academic year this week. Ask God to equip, bless and encourage students, staff and others who spend time in schools. Pray too for staff in local education authorities. Remember those children with special education needs, learning difficulties or disabilities that make it harder for them to learn. Pray that the staff who support them will find the best ways of helping them.

Pray that older people living in care homes, hospitals and other institutions will be properly looked after and given dignity and love by family, friends, staff and volunteers. Ask God to give patience and compassion to carers of the neediest patients.

Saturday 10 September is World Suicide Prevention Day. Ask God to comfort those affected by someone close to them taking their life. Pray that more help will reach those at risk of suicide, so that the tragically high annual figure of 800,000 may be reduced and many individuals rescued and restored.

The International Mission Centre offers training for BMS personnel. Pray for: (1) the new students as they settle in; (2) the Action Team members as they begin their one month training period, that this will be a time in which they grow in faith and be prepared for their service overseas; (3) for the teaching staff – Arthur, Nicky, Phil, Claire and Mark – as they provide training for people from a wide range of backgrounds, heading to a variety of contexts and tasks.
