Pray also for protection and justice to women and girls who are victims of brutality and sexual assault from militias, armed gangs, traffickers and even their relatives in many countries around the world.

David and Margie Whitehorn have no immediate overseas trips for the first few months of this year, but ask for prayer as they use the time to catch up with some administrative work, help some of the smaller branches with some of their work, as well as the usual Skype calls, letters, and checking out new areas for ministry. Sunday 5 February is the annual BMS Day of Prayer. Pray for all the areas of their ministry – and particularly their vision to work in ten of the world's most fragile states, including Syria, Central African Republic, Chad, Guinea, and Afghanistan.
