

Prayer Points and Information

Ask that God will inspire each of us with a powerful sense of his presence and work among us and through us as his people.

Over half the preschool children in this country, and their carers or parents, are welcomed to one of the thousands of church-run toddler groups each week. Give thanks for the dedication of those who run such groups and pray that their contact with children and families will bear good fruit.

Pray for the 90 Parish Nurses supporting people with healthcare issues through local churches. Ask God to bless them as they provide advice, act as 'signposts' to various support or medical services, and bring a caring Christian presence into the community.

Pray that older people living in care homes, hospitals and other institutions will be properly looked after and given dignity and love by family, friends, staff and volunteers. Ask God to give patience and compassion to carers of the neediest patients.

A prayer from a Syrian pastor now living in Jordan: Lord our God, we come to you in faith, lifting our prayers to intercede for Syria and its suffering people. Lord, put an end to the fighting and guide those who seek peace and reconciliation. Send your peace, comfort and healing to the suffering and wounded, and give security and shelter to the needy. We trust that you hear and answer our prayers. To you be all the glory forever. Amen.
