

Prayer Points and Information

Pray for refreshment for parents and children during this period of holiday from school.

Let's pray for each other in the church, for a strengthening of our commitment to each other's welfare – rejoicing with those who rejoice, and weeping with those who weep.

Monday 7 April is World Health Day. Pray that the focus on preventing lethal diseases transmitted by mosquitoes and other insects will result in effective education and practical protection for children and adults who are at risk.

April is Autism Awareness Month. Pray for families caring for someone who is on the autistic spectrum, which affects how they communicate and relate to others. Pray that they will be able to access the information, encouragement and practical help they need at every stage.

Community development is a key focus of BMS World Mission and their partners, overseeing a number of projects aimed at reducing poverty and bringing opportunity and hope. Pray for: (1) the Indigenous Women's Empowerment Project which aims to improve livelihoods for women in rural Bangladesh; (2) the development of preschool education work in Angola in partnership with the Association of Angolan Baptist Churches; (3) for water and sanitation projects run by Nepali Baptists.
