Tuesday 8 November sees the Presidential Election in the USA. Let's ask God to direct the hearts of Americans who will vote today. Pray for his will to be done in the choice of the next President and that the whole country will be re-energised through Christ's reconciling grace and peace.

Pray for those pursuing peace in Syria and the surrounding areas as they attempt to bring hostilities to an end and enable humanitarian aid to reach those in need. Let's pray for lasting peace and genuine reconciliation to be found and that the thousands who were forced to flee can return and rebuild their lives.

Pray the BMS World Mission Dignity initiative – supporting communities worldwide to take a stand against gender based violence. Give thanks for all the ways Dignity has already had an impact on vulnerable women and girls overseas and for the UK churches who have responded to the initiative. Pray that BMS education, community, health and legal work in Afghanistan, India, East Africa, Thailand and the UK will continue to see injustice acknowledged and lives healed.
