Pray for those who continue to struggle with ill-health of different sorts – for grace in weakness, for a deep sense of God’s presence, and for restored strength.

A prayer about rights and responsibilities: ‘God of all justice, we remember those who suffer discrimination or persecution because of their faith. Help them to trust in you and be filled with patience and grace as they experience these trials. Please help us to recognise our responsibility to do whatever good we can in every area of our lives. Give us the courage to stand up on behalf of others who have been denied basic human rights and justice, and cannot defend themselves. Amen.’
