Give thanks for Charmaine, and continue to pray for wisdom and strength for her and the deacons as they shoulder the main responsibility for the oversight of the church and its activities.

A prayer for Wednesday 10 December, which is Human Rights' Day: 'Lord, we pray that more of the world's governments will honour the spirit of the 1948 Declaration of Human Rights, to respect the right of everyone to live peacefully in freedom. Please give courage to politicians, campaigners and journalists who are in danger, because of their stand for justice in places where this is threatened. Amen.'

Pray for David and Margie Whitehorn. Give thanks with them for Ruth and Mark's wedding in September, and pray for them as a new couple as they settle into marriage. David and Margie also ask for prayer for their visits to Guinea-Bissau (from now until 18 December) and Senegal (2-26 January 2015) – for preparations for the devotions they have been asked to give, and for profitable time with the team leaders and travels around the countries.

Since the elections earlier this year, there has been relative calm in Afghanistan, but incidences of violence continue and there is much uncertainty surrounding the future of the country. As western troops continue to pull out, let's pray for Afghanistan, and for missionaries as well as 'ordinary' Christians there – shining the light of Christ to their families, friends, neighbours, and colleagues across the country.
