

Prayer Points and Information

Pray for God's protection on those who are undergoing baptism in next week's Sunday service. Ask that God will bless them and their witness as they take this step of faith and obedience.

Remember the 250,000 children experiencing their parents' separation each year, and those whose families have already split, for whatever reason. Pray for strength and courage in the midst of these experiences and for the most vulnerable young people to be well supported.

Pray for David and Margie Whitehorn: (1) for wisdom as they monitor the Ebola outbreak in three African countries, and that it will be controlled and brought to an end; (2) for open borders for their next visits to Africa (Ghana in October, Guinea-Bissau in November, Senegal in January); (3) for all that needs to be done in the run-up to Ruth's wedding; (4) for Esther needing to discern God's leading and calling, and to find a job; (5) for good times with both their parents before going abroad again.

Pray for the ongoing work of ROPE – Release for Oppressed People Everywhere. Praise God for the amazing passion and commitment of Ropeholders to work in challenging situations, serving the poor and vulnerable in their communities. Pray for God's protection for Cathy, the Ropeholder in the Democratic Republic of Congo, who suffered a stroke and was hospitalised. Pray for her full recovery as she takes a month off and undergoes physiotherapy.
